### Bible Study

The word fear is mentioned 404 times in the Bible. These are the Hebrew and Greek words translated fear.

Here are the New Testament, Greek words.

Matthew 1:20 – **“PHOBEO” G5399** = frighten, to be alarmed (this in the passive voice) TF **G5401**  
**“PHOBOS”** = to be put in fear; alarm or fright

Luke 1:74 – **“APHOBOS” G870** = a compound word of G5401 and negative particle = fearlessly, without fear

1 Corinthians 16:10 – **“ATIMOS” G820** = unhonored, dishonored from negative particle and **G5092** – **“TIME”** = a value paid, valuing TF **5099** **“TINO”** = to pay a price, penalty

Philippians 2:12 – **“ECHO” G2192** = to hold, such as a possession; ability – one has the means to accomplish a task

2 Timothy 1:7 – **“DEILIA” G1167** = timidity- fear. Cowardice, unmanliness TF G1169 – faithless

Hebrews 11:7 – **“ELILABEOMAI” G2125** = to be circumspect; impl. Apprehensive, to be cautious, beware and reverence produced by holy fear TF **G2126** = carefully; taking well. Taking hold well.

Hebrews 12:21 – **“EKPHOBOS” G1630** = frightened out of one’s wits TF **G1537 & G1537** = origin **G1510** **“EIMI”** = I exist, I am, first person, singular

Hebrews 12:28 – **“ELILABEIA” G2124** = caution, (religiously), reverence, piety; holy fear; mingles fear and love TF **G2126** = taking well, carefully

The number one word used in the Greek for fear is PHOBOS G5401

The second most common word is PHOBEO G5399
